Museum activities have now restarted following a long closure as a result of COVID19 restrictions at Heriot-Watt University.

There is a lot of outstanding work to be completed and progress has been made in providing additional shelf space and consideration is currently being given refreshing a number of our displays.

Over the course of the year there have been seventeen acquisitions including a number of surveying instruments donated by Heriot-Watt University. In addition, two interesting related acquisitions with a John Rennie Snr connection have been purchased: they are 1) a sketch of Rennie Snr made by his son in 1822 using a *camera lucida* as reference for the creation of a die for a Rennie memorial medal and 2) an example of the actual medal struck.

Interestingly, the museum collection includes a malleable iron ship's rudder which was repurposed for use as an anchor plate for suspension cables on the Gattonside footbridge, Melrose which was opened in 1826. We have recently discovered that this rudder is a very early example of marine ironware and have been advised that it could be the oldest known example of marine ironware anywhere.

The museum is currently working towards accreditation with Museums Galleries Scotland (MGS). Accreditation with MGS will provide access to assistance and grants.
