## Canal plaque unveiled

The Union Canal was recognised this week at a plaque unveiling as a National Historic Civil Engineering Landmark, one of only two such awards granted in Scotland. Professor Roland Paxton of the Institution of Civil Engineers stated it was most fitting that the Union Canal with its great aqueducts striding across the Avon, Almond and Water of Leith valleys should gain this designation.
